

Instructions for Road to Oklahoma with Amy Ellis AmysCreativeSide.com

Cutting 6" block

Print fabric, cut:

6 squares - 2" x 2"

2 squares - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

White fabric, cut:

6 squares - 2" x 2"

2 squares - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Cutting 12" block

Print fabric, cut:

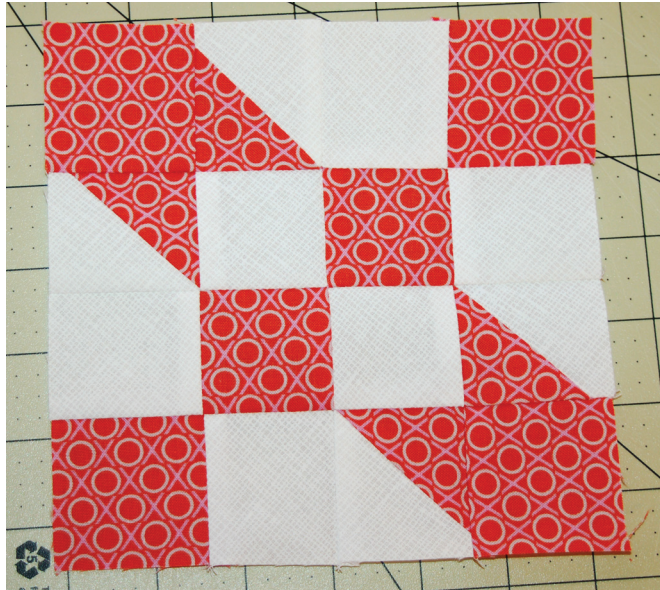
6 squares - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

2 squares - 4" x 4"

White fabric, cut:

6 squares - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

2 squares - 4" x 4"



Piecing Instructions:

Both size blocks are pieced in the same manner.

1. Mark a diagonal on the wrong side of the 2 larger white squares, pair with an equal sized square in print and sew 1/4" away from both sides the marked line.
2. Cut on the diagonal line, press the seam allowances in one direction, and trim to equal the size of the remaining squares, 2" or 3 1/2" respectively.
3. Layout the pieces in the block formation. Sew the squares together to form rows, press the seam allowances in opposite directions.
4. Sew the rows together to complete the block. Press the seam allowances in one direction.
