1. A new needle on the sewing machine - I love Superior's Top Stitching Titanium Needles
2. A fresh rotary blade on the rotary cutter - My go to is the ENDURANCE by OLFA
3. Accurate rulers for cutting - 6 1/2' x 24" is the most versatile, and great for a beginner, but smaller rulers make lots of cutting more enjoyable too.
4. A speaker for my tunes - all that cutting needs a playlist.
5. A hot iron to press all my seams flat.



6. Small basket in the corner of the cutting mat for trimmings - this saves me time from running back and forth to the waste basket.
7. Pins for matching seams - Clover extra fine patchwork pins are my absolute favorite.
8. A hearty seam ripper - Seam Fix has a silicon "eraser" for removing the bits of thread left in your seam.
9. Ipad or TV for some netflix while piecing
10. Marking tools - Clover mark-b-gone has been the most long-lasting water soluble tool in my statsh.
